HABILITATION THESIS

LANGUAGE BETWEEN SYSTEM AND DISCOURSE. GENERAL LINGUISTICS. HISTORY OF LANGUAGE. STYLISTICS AND POETICS

-ABSTRACT-

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The Habilitation thesis entitled *Language between system and discourse. General linguistics. History of language. Stylistics and Poetics* describes my scientific and professional achievements in the period after obtaining the title of Doctor of Philology (2003) and the plan of career development. The thesis documents firstly my teaching and research investigating the Romanian linguistic and general linguistics, but beyond that, it has an interdisciplinary character, engaging subjects and disciplines such as history of Romanian literary language, stylistics, poetics, psycholinguistics, dialectology. The work is based on original achievements resulting from scientific and educational activities. The thesis is structured as it follows:

1. Scientific and professional achievements, presenting following subdivisions:

- 1.1. The professional training, which mentions the degree in Philology (University "Lucian Blaga", Faculty of Letters, History and Journalism, Specialization in German Language and Literature Romanian Language and Literature, 1997), a Postgraduate Diploma (LBUS, Faculty of Letters, History and Journalism, Specialization Stylistic of Romanian language, 1998), the degree of Doctor of Philology (LBUS, magna cum laude, 2003).
- 1.2. Teaching activities established on four levels: a) university degrees held (currently Associate Professor at the Faculty of Letters and Arts LBUS); b) disciplines taught in higher education institutions; c) publishing educational materials; d) organization of scientific manifestations ("Lucian Blaga" (Inter)National Student Colloquium); e) Inter-university experience (national and international).
- 1.3. The Scientific activity, detailed in the following levels:
- 1.3.1. Participation to national and international scientific events. Until now, I was a member of the organizing committee of an international conference in Romania and member of the organizing committee of a national inter-university conference in Romania. I also participated with 40 papers to scientific events held in Romania.
- 1.3.2. Participation in national and international research projects. Until this moment, I participated as a member to a national research project.
- 1.3.3. Papers published. Until now, I have published, as author 4 volumes (Language and

Relevant scientific contributions in the field of linguistic studies cover a separate section and they concern the following topics: A. G. Coşbuc - expressive language; poetic etnomithology (Mithopoetics), creator of language; B. History of the Romanian literary language (contribution to a new periodization of the literary Romanian, researching the main problems of the literary Romanian language and Romanian linguistic monuments); C. General and Applied Linguistics (problems related to the general theory of language, Historic Linguistics and Comparative Linguistics, language pathology, distortions of communication, expressive distortions, linguistic laspus etc.); D. New Directions in linguistics (developing a model of language acquisition).

- 1.3.4. Professional recognition, which focuses on five issues: a) awards and distinctions; b) membership of scientific and professional associations (4, two international and two national); c) reviews and citations of my works (5 citations); d) professional expertise; e) presence in international databases and libraries of prestigious universities in Romania and abroad.
- 2. The plan relating to the evolution and development of the professional, scientific, academic career. Research/ teaching directions/ practical applications and probable manners of action for their instrumentalization. For these aspects, I have considered two career development directions: a) didactic activity; b) publication of books as sole author (Development and publication of a treaty on general linguistics, to update the main views, directions and concerns in world publishing a monograph dialect of the village from where some of my ancestors. The research shall be organized in collaboration with the Mayor's Office of which the village and starts an investigation dialectal spot, based on a special questionnaire drawn up; Documentation for publishing a book by the author on the topic of a number of neuropsychiatric disorders involving language (especially aphasias Broca and Wernicke) Develop a course Psycholinguistics; Writing of the second part of the history of literary Romanian, covering the period 1780 (appearance of the first grammars printed in Romanian) and 1840 (when Dacia literary) two decisive moments in Romanian culture, and active involvement in promoting Romanian culture and language, possibly in a Romanian language lectureship abroad (currently teaching-related activities with foreign students enrolled at ULBS); Achieving a comprehensive work on versions of the Bible in Romanian, approach towards whom I contacted several experts from prestigious foreign universities (Emory and Harvard); Creating a database using a specially designed soft on Romanian language grammars (will be implemented with resolve copyright issues); Creating a database and a software to mimic and to exemplify the language acquisition Romanian native speakers and in parallel to the bi- or multilinguals.
